Bring:

1. Crate & mat – crate from car, small crating rooms or outside in the shade.
2. Mask & Chair – you'll need to wear a mask during certain times of the seminar.
3. Dog stuff: water bowl, treats, toys, chews poop bags. Absolutely NO CRUMBLY treats!!
4. LUNCH: There are fast food restaurants 10-15 minutes away, but Suggest you bring yours!
5. Notebook & Pen

Location: Karen's Place, 4720 NW 143rd St, Gainesville, FL 32606 – This is a private facility located NW of Gainesville on fenced 5 acres.

Arena: Covered 120x80 on soccer turf with infill. Make sure you potty your dog before your turn, avoiding any accidents.

Time: 9:00 am – 5:00 pm. Please arrive early enough to get set up, potty your dog, etc. Be ready before 9am

COVID Precautions: Masks are required unless working with your dog or you can't Social distance from other attendees. Crate in your car if possible. Bring your own hand sanitizer and use frequently.

Dog Potty Area: Anywhere. Pick up after your dog, dispose in small metal cans. **HUMAN Bathroom:** in obedience bldg

Attendees: Only registered working participants will be allowed at the seminar. There are 7 workers.

Courses: 2 - ISC type jumpers courses with international challenges. They will be challenging, but Sheyla does a fantastic job breaking them down and applying distance handling options where appropriate.

Video Policy: You may have someone else in the class video you when you are working your dog. You may not film anyone else without their consent. If you post on social media, mute the audio.

Dog Safety: Please be mindful of your spacing around other dogs. Try to avoid any lunging, snapping or barking
